Indications:

- A.)** For growing cattle (over 400 lb) for reduction of liver condemnation due to liver abscesses
- B.)** For cattle for the prevention and treatment of the early stages of shipping fever complex.
- C.)** For calves and beef and nonlactating dairy cattle for the treatment of bacterial enteritis caused by *E. coli* and bacterial pneumonia (shipping fever complex) caused by *Pasteurella multocida* susceptible to oxytetracycline; treatment and control of colibacillosis (bacterial enteritis) caused by *E. coli* susceptible to neomycin.
- D.)** For calves (up to 250 lb) for the treatment of bacterial enteritis caused by *E. coli* susceptible to oxytetracycline; treatment and control of colibacillosis (bacterial enteritis) caused by *E. coli* susceptible to neomycin.

For indications C and D withdraw 5 days before slaughter. A withdrawal period has not been established in preruminating calves; do not use in calves to be processed for veal. A milk discard time has not been established for use in lactating dairy cattle; do not use in female dairy cattle 20 months of age or older. Use of more than one product containing neomycin or failure to follow withdrawal times may result in illegal drug residues.
