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Residue Warning: At 500 g/ton level, withdraw 24 hours before slaughter. Zero-day withdrawal period for lower use levels. Do not use in low-calcium feed containing less than 0.55% dietary calcium. Use in such feeds may result in violative residues. Do not administer to chickens producing eggs for human consumption.
